Day 5- Skagway (Frí, Jun 12)

Today we wake up and find ourselves in my favorite stop of the trip, Skagway. Skagway, Alaska is the northernmost point in Alaska's Inside Passage. In its heyday, Skagway was the boomtown gateway to the Trail of '98 and the Klondike gold fields. The population has dwindled from 20,000 feverish gold seekers to about 1000 year-round citizens. Skagway is home to the White Pass and Yukon Railroad, the "Scenic Railway of the World." This popular attraction show should not be missed. This





Day 6- Endícott Arm and Dawes Glacíer (Sat, Jun 13)

Today will be a day of relaxation as we sail through Endicott Arm and Dawes Glacier. Sailing into Endicott Arm, Alaska offers a breathtaking experience with towering cliffs, icy blue glaciers, and abundant wildlife. The journey through this fjord is a highlight of many Alaska cruises, often culminating in a close encounter with Dawes Glacier. Expect to see dramatic scenery, including cascading waterfalls, floating icebergs, and diverse wildlife like seals, eagles, and poten-

tially bears or whales.

Day 7- Ketchíkan (Sun, Jun 14)

We will arrive into Ketchikan early in the morning. Ketchikan is known as "The Salmon Capital of the World." It is located in the midst of the Tongass National Forest, a 17 million acre rainforest full of lush cedar, Sitka spruce, waterfalls, and wildlife. We are in Ketchikan from 7:00am until 3:00pm.

Day 8 - Day at Sea— (Mon, Jun 15)

Today is our last day at sea. Time to reflect and sit back and relax.

Day 9 - Vancouver—Home (Tues, Jun 16)

We will arrive back into Seattle early morning. We will make our way back to the airport and take with us many lasting memories we have of our Alaskan adventure as well as memories of times shared with our travel family.
