Day 1 Overnight Flight

Day 1: Wednesday, March 17, 2027 Overnight Flight Iconic skylines of picturesque towers. A trend-setting culinary scene. The inspirational muse of the world's greatest artists. Fashion-forward *haute couture*. This is the "City of Light." Feel the essence of Paris as the locals do – with its chic cosmopolitan vibe and constant energy. You're on your way to a five-night stay in the thriving heartbeat of France.

Day 2: Thursday, March 18, 2027 Paris, France Be swept off your feet as the Paris of your dreams comes alive. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Tonight, say *salut* as you toast the beginning of your tour and savor a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

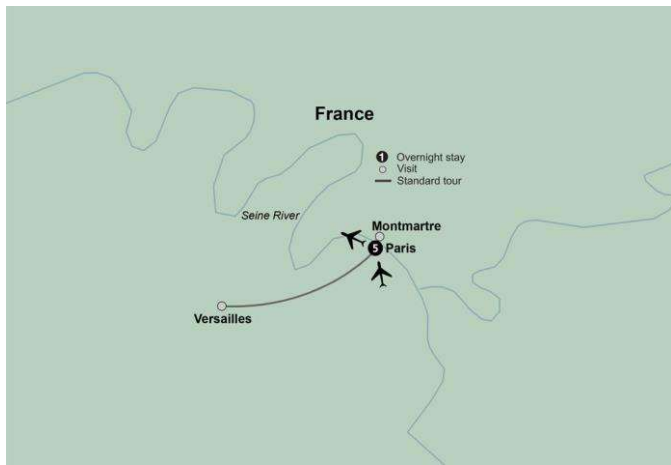
Day 3: Friday, March 19, 2027 Paris: The Louvre & Seine River Dinner Cruise Step into the shoes of a local and navigate *Le Métro*, your main mode of transportation for the week. Get to know this underground system with a local pro, giving you the freedom to set off later as you wish. First stop – the Louvre Museum.* The ethereal glass pyramid at the Louvre's entrance serves as your gateway to another realm, where ancient sculptures lead to 19th-century canvases. Wander past and marvel at the palette progeny of Raphael and Botticelli before making your way to Da Vinci's renowned *Mona Lisa*. On the next stop, your cultural lessons continue into the Quartier Latin, the intellectual and bohemian heart of Paris, known for its historic universities and lively streets. Then, stroll to the nearby *Île de la Cité*, the city's ancient core, where the majestic Notre Dame Cathedral** stands – an 850-year-old Gothic masterpiece watching over the Seine. As your day wraps up, make the most of it, and admire the city skyline as you gently float down the Seine on a dinner cruise. (B, D)

Day 4: Saturday, March 20, 2027 Paris - Versailles - Paris Channel your inner royal at Versailles, an iconic palace located in the heart of France. There's a reason why Versailles has served as a model for countless international abodes, which you'll discover as you wind your way through sprawling gardens and palace halls with a local guide. From the Hall of Mirrors to the opulent bedchamber of the Queen, take in the palace's most famous sights. Afterward, a visit to Versailles wouldn't be complete without venturing beyond the palace, so take some time to explore the local market.*** This evening, experience Parisian nightlife during an optional dinner at the dynamic Paradis Latin**** for a champagne-flowing, can-can kicking, music-driven night at the cabaret. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, March 21, 2027 Paris - Optional Excursion to Normandy***** Enjoy the day on your own, exploring Paris however you wish. If you'd prefer to venture beyond Paris, you can choose to join a full-day optional tour to Normandy, retracing the history of World War II with visits to see the Mulberry harbour (an engineering marvel), the Normandy American Cemetery, and the D-Day landing site at Omaha Beach. (B)

Day 6: Monday, March 22, 2027 Paris: Montmartre & Eiffel Tower Dinner Today, spend the morning exploring the hip, bohemian neighborhood of Montmartre. Blending artistic roots and quirky modernity, this 18th *arrondissement* neighborhood is home to classical painters and cultural provocateurs. Have some free time to head inside Sacré-Coeur and take in the city from this iconic hilltop basilica and enjoy a stop at a café. Then, **it's your choice!** Venture into the Musée de Montmartre to get a glimpse into the roots of cabaret and the lives of Paris's most famous artists with a local guide **-OR-** step off the tourist trail for a peaceful stroll through the Montmartre Cemetery. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure to explore Paris as you please. Nothing compares to the view from within the Eiffel Tower,***** where you'll enjoy an exclusive dinner featuring savory French cuisine. (B, D)

Day 7: Tuesday, March 23, 2027 Paris - Tour Ends *Au revoir!* Your tour comes to a close today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 4. This means you're ready to seize the day, whatever it may bring. You lead an active life at home (walking, biking, and half or full day hikes are things you may enjoy) and 10,000 steps a day is normal for you. You can handle longer walking tours (more than 3 hours covering 3+ miles at a steady clip) and activities that involve traversing uneven terrain, steep slopes, standing for periods of time, and varying altitudes and temperatures. You don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late nights, and full days. You can handle altitudes of 9,000 feet or higher with little to no issue. This level is not appropriate for travelers who use wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility assistance devices.

You will be travelling by metro throughout Paris for a majority of this tour and should be reasonably fit in order to get on and off this mode of transportation.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

**Notre-Dame does not require reservations for entry. Please note that guided visits inside are not permitted, and access is subject to the queue on the day. Depending on the available free time, guests may or may not be able to enter.

*On the rare occasion the Louvre Museum is not available, it will be replaced by another high-level Paris museum.

***Local markets in France may change timing or day of the week pattern.

*****Due to high demand for the Eiffel Tower restaurant, your dining time can be as late as 9:00 p.m. The restaurant will give you access to level 1 of the Eiffel Tower. Be prepared for security lines before reaching the restaurant. The menu, crafted by a renowned chef, is high quality but offers no choices.

****Normandy Optional Tour: If you choose this option, due to the long distances (approximately 360 miles / 579 km roundtrip), expect to start the day early in the morning and return late (approximately 12 hours from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.).

Normandy: D-Day Beaches & American Cemetery

Retrace the history of World War II in Normandy. Trek north from Paris about 175 miles to Arromanche-les-Bains. See Mulberry Harbor, one of the greatest engineering feats of WWII that allowed the Allies to establish strategic bridgeheads on D-Day. Pause for a break then continue to the Normandy American Cemetery. Take time to pay respects to the 9,386 servicemen and women who have been laid to rest here. Conclude your time in Normandy at a D-Day landing site: Omaha Beach. *Duration: Approximately 12 hours.* Please note a minimum of 25 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
